

## Public Hearing Notice

Early County is considering requesting a community development block grant of up to \$750,000.00 from the Georgia Department of Community Affairs. These funds should be used primarily to benefit low-and middle-income people. These funds can be used for activities in the areas of housing, public facilities, and economic development. More specific details on eligible activities will be provided, plans to assist displaced persons (if any), the approximate amount of funds proposed for activities that benefit low-and middle-income persons, and the system of classification at a public hearing to be held at the Early County Theater located at 202 Court Square in Blakley, Georgia on February 21, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. The reason for this hearing will be to obtain citizen opinions on the development of the application and review the progress of the previous CDBG grant (if applicable).
